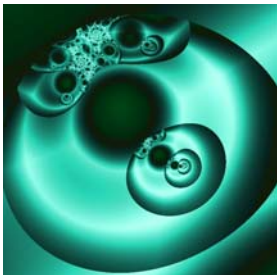
On **Thursday, April 21**, you are invited to discover the deeply hopeful scientific truths that underlie this summer's upcoming site-specific theatre extravaganza, *Other Freds*, when The Only Animal presents a panel discussion on parallel universes, quantum weirdness, and the possible existence of Other Vancouvers. The panel is free and open to the public, and is presented in partnership with the Roundhouse Community Centre.

Panelists include Dr. Douglas Scott, Cosmologist and Associate Professor of Physics and Astronomy at UBC and Dr. Philip Stamp, Professor of Condensed Matter Theory at UBC along with *Other Freds* director/playwright Kendra Fanconi and artists from Team Fred. The panel is facilitated by Amy Lynn Strilchuk.

The panel will discuss the possibilities of theatricalizing "quantum weirdness," and consider questions about the implications of our actions in this world on other possible worlds. Here's a chance to hear local experts on Parallel Universes talking with *Other Freds* artists about how to go about creating Other Vancouvers. You will also get details about how you can get involved as a performer/creator of *Other Freds*.

Other Freds promises to be one of the most exciting theatre events of the year. Presented by The Only Animal Theatre Society in partnership with the Roundhouse Community Centre, with support from Theatre SKAM and the Arts Club Theatre, *Other Freds* is the story of a lonely fella named Fred and all of the *Other Freds* in nearby parallel worlds. Besides a core of professional actors and musicians, the show will feature the participation of over 200 community members, plus two dozen boats, birds and bicycles. The largest and most audacious site-specific theatre show Vancouver has ever seen, *Other Freds* runs July 11-23rd outdoors on Granville Island.
